

Basic Pool Maintenance

Maintain Levels

To prevent skin & eye irritation, staining, and damage to linings.

pH levels: 7.2-7.6 (Marbelite pools) 7.0-7.2 (Fiberglass pools)	Test Frequency Weekly
Chlorine levels:	Test Frequency
1 - 3ppm	Weekly
Total Alkalinity (TA) levels:	Test Frequency
80 -120ppm	Monthly
Copper/Iron levels:	Test Frequency
0	Once per season
Stabiliser (Cyanuric acid) levels:	Test Frequency
Less than 50ppm	At least once per season
<i>NB: High stabiliser levels may result in insufficient free chlorine and harmful bacteria in your pool.</i>	Test monthly when using
Please follow label instructions when adding products to the pool	floaters
Filtering hours NB: Hours may vary due to pool volume and pump filters throughout. To calculate your pool volume: Length x Width x Depth x 1000	
Summer	12hrs per night
Winter	6 - 8hrs per night
Backwash/Rinse	Frequency
When your automatic pool cleaner becomes sluggish, backwash the filter for 2 minutes and rinse the filter for 20 seconds.	Every 2 weeks
Remove debris	Frequency
Clear pump and weir baskets	Weekly
Brush pool walls and floor	Frequency Weekly
